

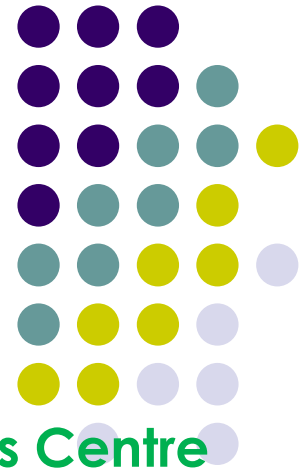

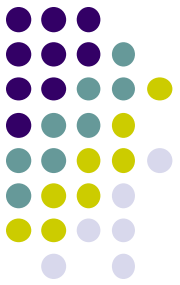
- The Aim of the Paper is to:
 - Reasons for Monitoring & Evaluation of Gender Based Violence (GVG) and Girls Child Protection (GCP) Initiatives.
 - Provide Brief on Essential Performance Indicators related to Sensitizations and Advocacy on Gender Based Violence and Girls Child Protection that Needs Reporting.

Reasons for Monitoring & Evaluation of GVG and GCP

- To Provide management and the main *stakeholders* of the policy /strategy/programme/project such Gender Based Violence(GBV) and and Girls Child Protection (GCP) with:
 - ✓ indications of the extent of progress and achievement of objectives the of the Gender Based Violence and and Girls Child Protection Sensitizations and Advocacies
 - ✓ understanding of whether things Planned on GBV and GCP are on track or not,
 - ✓ and whether you are doing what you planned to do or not under GBV and GCP,.

Reasons for Monitoring & Evaluation of GVG and GCP

- To Provide a **periodic assessment**, as systematic and objective as possible, of an ongoing or completed project, programme, strategy or policy, its design, implementation and results such as Gender Based Violence and and Girls Child Protection Sensitization and Advocacy with the aim of determining whether what is done is:
 - ✓ **Relevance** to achieving of objectives of GBV and GCP,
 - ✓ **Coherence** with other similar initiatives working on GBV and GCP,
 - ✓ **Value for money** in the Process of Implementation of GBV and GCP, ,
 - ✓ **Effectiveness** i.e. achievement of set targets of GBV and GCP,,
 - ✓ **Impact** i.e. the changes in the lives of beneficiaries/citizens as perceived by them of the GBV and GCP,
 - ✓ **Sustainability** in the implementation of the GBV and GCP,

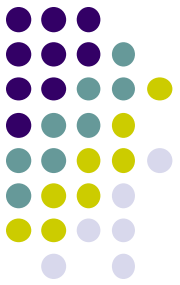


Impact Level Indicators

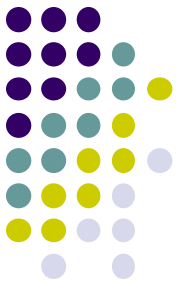
- **Reduction in GBV Incidents:** Measure the decrease in reported cases or prevalence rates of gender-based violence within the targeted community or region.
- **Improved Support Services Accessibility and** utilization of support services such as hotlines, shelters, counseling centers, etc., by survivors of GBV.
- **Change in Societal Attitudes** towards GBV, gender equality, and girls' rights.

GBV & GCP Performance Indicators

Outcomes Level Indicators



- **Change in Level of Knowledge and Awareness** and understanding of GBV issues among the communities whose members have benefitted from the Sensitizations and Advocacies.
- **Increase in Policy and Legal Changes/ Reforms** due to the advocacy efforts in favor of girls' protection and GBV prevention.
- **Increase in Community Engagements** of community members in activities related to GBV prevention and girls' protection.

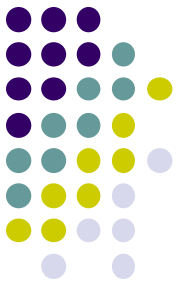


Outputs Level Indicators

Number of Sensitization Programs Conducted such as number of workshops, training sessions, seminars, and campaigns organized on GBV and girls' protection.

Number of Individuals Reached and Engaged through the Sensitizations and Advocacy programs.

Number/Quantity of Educational Materials Disseminated and distributed such as brochures, posters, etc., related to GBV awareness and girls' protection.

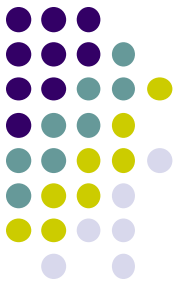


Activities Level

Frequency of Training Sessions such as training sessions or workshops are conducted on GBV prevention and girls' rights.

Stakeholder Engagements such as the involvement and collaboration with various stakeholders like NGOs, government agencies, community leaders, etc.

Advocacy Efforts such as the number of advocacy campaigns initiated, petitions signed, or policy dialogues held to address GBV and girls' protection issues.



Inputs Level

Measure of Financial Resources such as the budget allocated and spent on GBV sensitization and advocacy programs.

Number of Human Resources i.e. staff and expertise of staff/volunteers dedicated to these initiatives

Number of Partnerships and Resources Mobilized such as the acquisition of partnerships, grants, or in-kind resources secured to support the programs.
